

Bylaw 11-2024

OF THE TOWN OF BRUDERHEIM

(herein referred to as “the Municipality”)

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BRUDERHEIM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH FEES, RATES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIAPLITY.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, SA 2000, Chapter M-26 (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”), as amended, provides that a municipality may pass bylaws for Municipal purposes respecting services provided by the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Act provides for the establishment of fees for licenses, permits and approvals of Bylaws;

AND WHEREAS the Act provides for provision of Municipal Utility services subject to the terms, costs or charges established by Council;

AND WHEREAS the Act provides that a Municipality can provide copies of information on payment of a reasonable fee as established by Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Bruderheim, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1) That the Fees and Charges attached as Schedule “A” to this Bylaw, represent the Fees, Rates and Charges applicable to the Municipal Services provided by the Town of Bruderheim.

This Bylaw comes into effect on January 1, 2025

Read a first time this 22nd day of January 2025.

Read a second time this 19th day of February 2025.

Read a third time and finally passed this 19th day of February 2025.
