

BYLAW 07-2023

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BRUDERHEIM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO SPECIFY THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS SITTING ON THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act states that the Council of a City or Town consists of seven (7) Councillors unless the council passes a bylaw specifying a higher or lower odd number;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Bruderheim, in the Province of Alberta, has the authority to increase or decrease the number of Councillors, as specified in the Municipal Government Act.


NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of the Town of Bruderheim, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Municipal Council for the Town of Bruderheim shall decrease to five (5) with the General Election in October 2025 and shall consist of the following:
 - a. A Chief Elected Official, otherwise referred to as the "Mayor," to be elected by separate ballot, and:
 - b. Four (4) Councillors; to be elected at large.
2. The Bylaw comes into force upon the date of the third and final reading.


Read a first time this 16th of August, 2023

Read a second time this 15th of November, 2023

Read a third time and finally passed this 15th of November, 2023
